

## **Kodak's Columbus Facility Wins in Consolidation Move**

Eastman Kodak Co. says by the end of 2009, it will shut down its Windsor, Colorado printing plate manufacturing operation and transfer the work to its facility in Columbus, Georgia.

The Columbus facility found itself with extra capacity following the investment in a new production line resulting in 50 new jobs in Corporate Ridge Business Park.

The move is part of Kodak's ongoing efforts to "maintain competitiveness and maximize utilization of worldwide manufacturing capacity," the Rochester-based company said.
